

House Bill 1430

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to general provisions relative to identification and regulation of motor vehicles and
3 traffic, so as to prohibit a motor vehicle traffic stop on the sole basis that the person is
4 operating a motorcycle or wearing motorcycle paraphernalia; to provide for related matters;
5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 1 of Chapter 1 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9 general provisions relative to identification and regulation of motor vehicles and traffic, is
10 amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

11 "40-1-9.

12 A police officer may, upon reasonable articulable suspicion that a motor vehicle is being
13 operated in violation of any provision of this title, stop or detain such vehicle. A
14 reasonable articulable suspicion that utilizes the fact that a person is operating a motorcycle
15 or wears motorcycle related paraphernalia as the sole basis for a traffic stop shall be
16 unlawful."
