A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Oxford, approved April 13, 2001  
2 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4195), as amended, so as to change the corporate limits of such municipality;  
3 to provide for related matters; to provide for a contingent effective date; to repeal conflicting  
4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Oxford, approved April 13, 2001  
8 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4195), as amended, is amended by adding a new subsection to Section 1.11  
9 to read as follows:

10 "(c) In addition to the area now included in the corporate limits of the City of Oxford, the  
11 following area shall be included in the corporate limits of such municipality:

12 All those tracts or parcels of land lying and being in Land Lots 270, 271, 287 and 288 of  
13 the 9th Land District, Newton County, Georgia, and being Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11,  
14 per plat of survey for John Little Subdivision, prepared by Patrick and Associates, Inc.,  
15 Louie D. Patrick, GA RLS No. 1757, dated 09/24/07, recorded 10/23/07 at Plat Book 47,  
16 Pages 217-220, Newton County, Georgia records.

17 Said properties respectively being now known as 9101, 9121, 9131, and 9141 Aaron  
18 Drive, and 7101, 7111, and 7135 Keegan Court, Oxford, Georgia 30054, and formerly  
19 known as 9101, 9121, 9131, and 9141 Aaron Drive, and 7101, 7111, and 7135 Keegan  
20 Court, Covington, Georgia 30014, in accordance with the current system of numbering  
21 houses in Newton County, Georgia."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which  
24 it is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval, provided that an Act  
25 deannexing the territory described in this Act from the City of Covington is enacted in  
26 the 2024 session of the General Assembly.

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
