A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 27-2-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to trout
- 2 license, Georgia waterfowl and migratory bird stamp, big game license, and alligator harvest
- 3 permit, so as to provide for Georgia turkey stamps; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 27-2-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to trout license,
- 8 Georgia waterfowl and migratory bird stamp, big game license, and alligator harvest permit,
- 9 is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 10 "(c)(1) It shall be unlawful for any person who has attained the age of 16 years to hunt
- migratory game birds unless such person has in his or her possession a Georgia waterfowl
- and migratory bird stamp in addition to the required hunting license; provided, however,
- that a Georgia waterfowl and migratory bird stamp or a landowner Georgia waterfowl and
- migratory bird stamp shall be required for any resident of this state to hunt migratory birds
- on premises owned by him or her or his or her immediate family.

16	(2)(A) Any resident of this state may purchase a Georgia turkey stamp for a fee
17	of \$10.00. The department shall design the Georgia turkey stamp.
18	(B) It shall be unlawful for any person who has attained the age of 16 years and is not
19	a resident of this state to hunt turkey unless such person has in his or her possession a
20	Georgia turkey stamp in addition to the required hunting license. The fee for the stamp
21	shall be \$100.00."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
