

House Bill 1508

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 27-2-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to trout  
2 license, Georgia waterfowl and migratory bird stamp, big game license, and alligator harvest  
3 permit, so as to provide for Georgia turkey stamps; to provide for related matters; to repeal  
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 27-2-6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to trout license,  
8 Georgia waterfowl and migratory bird stamp, big game license, and alligator harvest permit,  
9 is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

10 "(c)(1) It shall be unlawful for any person who has attained the age of 16 years to hunt  
11 migratory game birds unless such person has in his or her possession a Georgia waterfowl  
12 and migratory bird stamp in addition to the required hunting license; provided, however,  
13 that a Georgia waterfowl and migratory bird stamp or a landowner Georgia waterfowl and  
14 migratory bird stamp shall be required for any resident of this state to hunt migratory birds  
15 on premises owned by him or her or his or her immediate family.

16 (2)(A) Any resident of this state may purchase a Georgia turkey stamp for a fee  
17 of \$10.00. The department shall design the Georgia turkey stamp.

18 (B) It shall be unlawful for any person who has attained the age of 16 years and is not  
19 a resident of this state to hunt turkey unless such person has in his or her possession a  
20 Georgia turkey stamp in addition to the required hunting license. The fee for the stamp  
21 shall be \$100.00."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
