A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to designate the fourth Friday in November of each year as
- 3 "National Sugarcane Syrup Day" in Georgia; to provide legislative findings and declarations;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 The General Assembly finds that:
- 8 (1) Making sugarcane syrup has been a part of family farm tradition for generations,
- 9 particularly in Georgia;
- 10 (2) The increase in production costs, competition from artificial syrups, and the decreasing
- 11 number of farmers who still make sugarcane syrup, however, has led some to refer to the
- making of sugarcane syrup as a dying art;
- 13 (3) Establishing a "National Sugarcane Syrup Day" in Georgia would help to preserve the
- 14 art of making sugarcane syrup by honoring those who continue with this long-standing
- 15 family farm tradition and by raising public awareness of the differences between natural
- sugarcane syrup and artificial syrups;

17 (4) Designating the fourth Friday in November of each year, the day after Thanksgiving,

- as "National Sugarcane Syrup Day" is particularly fitting, as it is not only a time when
- 19 families gather and celebrate together, but also a time when some say sugarcane is at its
- sweetest in Georgia; and
- 21 (5) It is, therefore, abundantly fitting and proper that the State of Georgia appropriately
- 22 recognize and honor the family farm tradition of making sugarcane syrup by designating
- the fourth Friday in November of each year as "National Sugarcane Syrup Day" in Georgia.
- SECTION 2.
- 25 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 27 "<u>1-4-27.</u>
- The fourth Friday in November of each year is designated as 'National Sugarcane Syrup
- 29 <u>Day' in Georgia."</u>
- 30 SECTION 3.
- 31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
