## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to prohibited acts regarding alcoholic beverages, so as to permit counties and
- 3 municipalities by resolution or ordinance to reduce the prohibited distances from school
- 4 buildings and other sites in which eating establishments may sell beer and wine for
- 5 consumption on the premises; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 6 for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- prohibited acts regarding alcoholic beverages, is amended by revising Code Section 3-3-21,
- 11 relating to sales of alcoholic beverages near churches, school buildings, or other sites, by
- 12 adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 13 "(f) Nothing in this Code section shall prohibit an eating establishment which is licensed
- 14 for the sale of only wine and malt beverages for consumption on the premises from selling
- wine and malt beverages on the premises within a distance closer to a school building,
- school grounds, college campus, or housing authority property, where so permitted by
- 17 <u>resolution or ordinance of the county or municipal governing authority. For purposes of</u>
- 18 <u>this subsection, the term 'eating establishment' means an establishment which derives at</u>
- 19 <u>least 50 percent of its total annual gross food and beverage sales from the sale of prepared</u>
- 20 meals or food."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
