A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 holidays and observances, so as to designate March 10 of each year as "Harriet Tubman
3 Day"; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
7 observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

8 "1-4-26.

9 March 10 of each year is designated as 'Harriet Tubman Day' in Georgia in recognition and
10 honor of Harriet Tubman, an American abolitionist, humanitarian, and hero."

12 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
