## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to designate March 10 of each year as "Harriet Tubman
- 3 Day"; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- 7 observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 8 "1-4-26.
- 9 March 10 of each year is designated as 'Harriet Tubman Day' in Georgia in recognition and
- 10 honor of Harriet Tubman, an American abolitionist, humanitarian, and hero."
- SECTION 2.
- 12 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
