- 19 (2) A county or municipal governing authority that owns or operates, or both, a
- 20 <u>commercial service airport may authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption</u>
- 21 <u>on the premises in eating establishments located within a sterile area of such commercial</u>
- service airport on Sundays between the hours of 5:00 A.M. and 12:00 Midnight."
