## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to driving on right side of roadway, overtaking and passing, and following too
- 3 closely, so as to clarify what constitutes an obstruction for purposes of exceptions to when
- 4 a vehicle is to drive on the right side of the roadway; to provide for proper operation of a
- 5 motor vehicle when overtaking a bicyclist; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 3 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 driving on right side of roadway, overtaking and passing, and following too closely, is
- amended by revising Code Section 40-6-40, relating to vehicles to drive on right side of
- 12 roadway, exceptions, and impeding traffic, as follows:
- 13 "40-6-40.
- 14 (a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width, a vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of
- the roadway, except as follows:

16 (1) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under 17 the rules governing such movement;

- 18 (2) When an obstruction exists making it necessary to drive to the left of the center of the
- highway, provided that any person so doing shall yield the right of way to all vehicles
- traveling in the proper direction upon the unobstructed portion of the highway within
- such a distance as to constitute an immediate hazard;
- 22 (3) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for traffic under the rules applicable
- 23 thereon; or
- 24 (4) Upon a roadway restricted to one-way traffic.
- 25 (b) Upon all roadways, any vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic at
- the time and place and under the conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand
- lane then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of
- 28 the roadway, except when overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same
- 29 direction or when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road or
- 30 driveway.
- 31 (c) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving traffic and providing for
- 32 two-way movement of traffic, no vehicle shall be driven to the left of the center of the
- 33 roadway except when authorized by official traffic-control devices designating certain
- lanes to the left of the center of the roadway for use by traffic not otherwise permitted to
- use such lanes or except as permitted under paragraph (2) of subsection (a) of this Code
- section. However, this subsection shall not be construed as prohibiting the crossing of the
- center of the roadway in making a left turn into or from an alley, private road, or driveway.
- 38 (d) No two vehicles shall impede the normal flow of traffic by traveling side by side at the
- same time while in adjacent lanes, provided that this Code section shall not be construed
- 40 to prevent vehicles traveling side by side in adjacent lanes because of congested traffic
- 41 conditions.

(e) For purposes of this Code section, the term 'obstruction' shall include any stationary
 vehicle or a vehicle moving at such a low rate of speed so as to hinder or impede proper
 travel upon the roadway."

45 SECTION 2.

- 46 Said article is further amended by revising Code Section 40-6-56, relating to safe passing
- 47 distance when overtaking a bicyclist, as follows:
- 48 "40-6-56.
- 49 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'safe distance' means not less than three feet.
- 50 (b)(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this article to the contrary, when feasible, the
- operator of a motor vehicle, when overtaking and passing a bicycle that is proceeding in
- 52 the same direction on the roadway, shall leave a safe distance between such vehicle and
- 53 the bicycle and shall maintain such clearance until safely past the overtaken bicycle.
- 54 (2) A vehicle may be driven to the left of the center of a highway in order to comply with
- 55 the requirements of this Code section, provided that any operator shall yield the right of
- way to all vehicles traveling in the opposite direction."

SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
