

House Bill 359

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 2A of Article 13 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to electric personal assistive mobility devices and personal delivery
3 devices, so as to prohibit the use of such devices for certain types of deliveries; to provide
4 for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Part 2A of Article 13 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
9 relating to electric personal assistive mobility devices and personal delivery devices, is
10 amended by revising Code Section 40-6-324, relating to transportation of hazardous
11 materials and exception for medical oxygen, as follows:

12 "40-6-324.

13 (a) No person shall carry or transport any hazardous materials on an electric personal
14 assistive mobility device or a personal delivery device. Oxygen carried for personal
15 medical reasons shall not be deemed a hazardous material for purposes of this Code
16 section.

17 (b) No person shall use an electronic personal assistive mobility device or personal
18 delivery device to transport any alcoholic beverages for purposes of any delivery provided
19 for in Code Section 3-3-10."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
22 without such approval.

23 **SECTION 3.**

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
