

House Bill 368

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 6 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to clerks of superior courts, so as to authorize certain certification training for such
3 clerks; to provide for a compensation supplement for the successful completion of such
4 certification training; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 2 of Chapter 6 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9 clerks of superior courts, is amended in Code Section 15-6-50, relating to clerk's term of
10 office, qualifications, training requirements, and appointment of clerk pro tempore during
11 training, by adding a new paragraph to subsection (c) to read as follows:

12 "(3.1) Each clerk of the superior court is authorized to voluntarily complete training
13 administered by the University of Georgia Carl Vinson Institute of Government resulting
14 in designation as a certified superior court clerk and in a compensation supplement as
15 provided for in Code Section 15-6-88.1."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 Said article is further amended by revising Code Section 15-6-88.1, which is designated as
18 reserved, as follows:

19 "15-6-88.1.

20 In addition to the minimum salary provided in Code Section 15-6-88 or any other salary
21 provided by an applicable general or local law, each clerk of superior court who has been
22 awarded a certificate from the University of Georgia, evidencing his or her successful
23 completion of the voluntary course of training administered by the Carl Vinson Institute
24 of Government resulting in designation as a certified superior court clerk shall be entitled

25 to a compensation supplement of \$200.00 per month to be paid from the funds of the
26 county Reserved."

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
