A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 43-1-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 expedited license by endorsement for spouses of active or transitioning members of the
3 armed forces, so as to shorten the time frame in which such licenses shall be issued once all
4 requirements are met; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date: to
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 43-1-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to expedited
9 license by endorsement for spouses of active or transitioning members of the armed forces,
10 is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

11 "(c) An expedited license by endorsement shall be issued no later than ~~90~~ 30 days from the
12 date of receipt of an application and information and documents that show that all of the
13 requirements of subsection (b) of this Code section have been met. Such application shall
14 only require such information and documentation necessary to verify that the applicant
15 meets the requirements set forth in subsection (b) of this Code section."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
18 without such approval.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
