A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

8 Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elementary and secondary education, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

10 "20-2-2072.

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The members of the governing board of the nonprofit organization of each charter school shall participate in initial training for boards of newly approved charter schools and annual training thereafter, conducted or approved by the state board. The state board shall provide for or approve such initial and annual training. The training shall include, but not be

limited to, best practices on school governance, the constitutional and statutory

requirements relating to public records and meetings, and the requirements of applicable

statutes and rules and regulations."

18 SECTION 2.

- 19 Said chapter is further amended by revising paragraph (12) of subsection (b) of Code Section
- 20 20-2-2083, relating to the powers and the duties of the State Charter Schools Commission,
- 21 as follows:
- 22 "(12) Provide for <u>or approve initial training for boards of newly approved state charter</u>
- 23 <u>schools and annual training thereafter</u>, as determined by the commission, for members
- of state charter school governing boards. The training shall include, but not be limited
- 25 to, best practices on school governance, the constitutional and statutory requirements

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26	relating to public records and meetings, and the requirements of applicable statutes and
27	rules and regulations."

28	SECTION 3
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- 29 Said chapter is further amended by revising subsection (f) of Code Section 20-2-2084,
- 30 relating to state charter school requirements, as follows:
- 31 "(f) The members of the governing board of each state charter school shall participate in
- 32 <u>initial training for boards of newly approved state charter schools and annual training</u>
- 33 <u>thereafter</u> conducted <u>or approved</u> by the commission pursuant to paragraph (12) of
- subsection (b) of Code Section 20-2-2083."

36 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
