A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions applicable to law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to clarify that
- 3 persons leaving establishments licensed to sell alcoholic beverages by the drink shall be
- 4 entitled to the defense of entrapment under certain circumstances; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions applicable to law enforcement officers and agencies, is amended by adding a new
- 10 Code section as follows:
- 11 "<u>35-1-18.</u>
- 12 A law enforcement officer approaching a person leaving an establishment licensed to sell
- 13 <u>alcoholic beverages by the drink when the person is on the property of such an</u>
- establishment and the officer approaches the person for the purpose of obtaining probable
- cause for crimes and offenses related to the consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be
- 16 considered to have entrapped such person for any such offense. A person subjected to such
- police entrapment shall be entitled to the defense of entrapment provided for in Code
- 18 <u>Section 16-3-25.</u>"

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
