A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 15-16-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 qualifications, training requirements, and exemptions for sheriffs, so as to clarify provisions
- 3 related to proof of eligibility to hold office; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 15-16-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to qualifications,
- 8 training requirements, and exemptions for sheriffs, is amended in paragraph (2) of subsection
- 9 (c) as follows:

- 10 "(2) Each person offering his or her candidacy for the office of sheriff shall, within 60
- days prior to or at the time such person qualifies:
- 12 (A) File with the officer before whom such person has qualified to seek the office of
- sheriff a certified copy of his or her birth certificate and a certified copy of his or her
- high school diploma, a certified copy of his or her high school transcript indicating the
- candidate has successfully graduated, or certified proof of its a recognized equivalent
- in education training as established by the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and
- 17 Training Council; and
- 18 (B) Swear or affirm before the officer before whom such person has qualified to seek
- the office of sheriff that he or she meets all of the qualifications required by this
- subsection, except as otherwise provided in subparagraph (J) of paragraph (1) of this
- subsection, and that he or she has complied with the requirements of subparagraph (G)
- of paragraph (1) of this subsection no later than the close of qualification for election
- 23 to the office of sheriff."

SECTION 2.
