The House Committee on Education offers the following substitute to HB 464:

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to local boards of education, so as to require local boards of education to have a
- 3 public comment period at every meeting; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to local
- 8 boards of education, is amended by revising Code Section 20-2-58, relating to regular
- 9 monthly meetings of local boards, adjournment, temporary presiding officer, and notice of
- 10 date, as follows:
- 11 "20-2-58.

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- 12 (a) It shall be the duty of each local board of education to hold a regular meeting during
- each calendar month for the transaction of business pertaining to the public schools. Any
- such meeting may be adjourned from time to time, and, in the absence of the president or
- secretary, the members of the local board may appoint one of their own number to serve
- temporarily. The local board shall annually determine the date of its meeting and shall
- publish it either in the official county organ or, at the option of the local board of education,
- in a newspaper having a general circulation in said county at least equal to that of the
- official county organ for two consecutive weeks following the setting of the date; provided,
- 20 however, that the date shall not be changed more often than once in 12 months and, if
- 21 changed, the new date shall also be published as provided in this Code section.
- 22 (b) Each local board of education shall provide a public comment period during every
- 23 regular monthly meeting. Such public comment period shall be included on the agenda
- 24 required to be made available and posted prior to the meeting pursuant to paragraph (1) of
- 25 <u>subsection (e) of Code Section 50-14-1</u>. A local board of education shall not require notice
- 26 by an individual prior to the date of the meeting as a condition of addressing the local board

- 27 <u>during such public comment period</u>. The chairperson of the local board of education shall
- 28 have the discretion to limit the length of time for individual comments and the number of

29 <u>individuals speaking for or against a specific issue."</u>

30 **SECTION 2.** 

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
