## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 3 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to emergency powers of the governor, so as to provide for the continued
- 3 operation of businesses during a public health state of emergency if they comply with certain
- 4 health and safety measures; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 3 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to emergency powers of the governor, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 "38-3-59.
- During any state of emergency declared by the Governor pursuant to Code Section 38-3-51
- due to a public health emergency, any business may continue or resume its operations if
- 14 the business complies with all of the applicable health and safety measures contained in
- any order, rule, or regulation issued pursuant to Articles 1 through 3 of this chapter in
- relation to such public health emergency."
