## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

- 2 relating to the state sales and use tax, so as to create an exemption for certain
- 3 telecommunications equipment used to provide telecommunications services; to provide for
- 4 definitions; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability;
- 5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
8	Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
9	state sales and use tax, is amended by deleting "or" at the end of paragraph (94), by replacing
0	the period with "; or" at the end of paragraph (95), and by adding a new paragraph to Code
1	Section 48-8-3, relating to exemptions from state sales and use taxes, read as follows:
12	"(96)(A) The sale or use of telecommunications equipment sold to, leased to, or used
13	by a telecommunications provider that is ultimately to be sold at retail, regardless of
4	whether purchased by the owner, a contractor, or a subcontractor.
15	(B) As used in this paragraph, the term:
16	(i) 'Telecommunications equipment' means any machinery, equipment, and fixtures
17	used in the provision of telecommunications services, including but not limited to:
8	(I) Machinery, equipment, and fixtures utilized in receiving, initiating, amplifying,
9	processing, transmitting, recording, switching, or monitoring telecommunications,
20	such as computers, switches, transformers, amplifiers, routers, bridges, repeaters,
21	multiplexers, and other items performing comparable functions;
22	(II) Machinery, equipment, and fixtures used in the transportation of
23	telecommunications services, such as central office equipment, switching and
24	private branch exchange equipment, satellite equipment, microwave equipment, and
25	other transporting media but not including wire, cable, fiber, poles, or conduit;

26	(III) Ancillary machinery, equipment, and fixtures that regulate, control, protect,
27	or enable any of the machinery, equipment, or fixtures described in divisions (i) and
28	(ii) of this subparagraph to accomplish its intended function, such as auxiliary
29	power supply, test equipment, towers, and heating, ventilating, and air conditioning
30	equipment necessary to the operation of any such machinery, equipment, and
31	<u>fixtures;</u>
32	(IV) Repair and replacement parts, including accessories, whether purchased as
33	spare parts, repair parts, or upgrades or modifications to any machinery, equipment,
34	or fixtures described in divisions (i) through (iii) of this subparagraph; and
35	(V) Software necessary to the operation of any machinery, equipment, or fixtures
36	described in divisions (i) through (iv) of this subparagraph.
37	(ii) 'Telecommunications provider' means any provider of telecommunications
38	services.
39	(C) Any person making a sale of telecommunications equipment to a
40	telecommunications provider shall collect the tax imposed on the sale by this article
41	unless the purchaser furnishes a certificate issued by the commissioner certifying that the
42	purchaser is entitled to purchase the telecommunications equipment without paying the
43	tax."
44	SECTION 2.

45 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its become law without such approval and shall apply to transactions which occur on or after that date. 46

47 **SECTION 3.** 

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 48
