## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to health regarding students in elementary and secondary education, so
- 3 as to require that a student shall be permitted to exit a classroom for use of the restroom upon
- 4 request; to provide for conditions; to provide for policy promulgation; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 9 relating to health regarding students in elementary and secondary education, is amended by 10 adding a new Code section to read as follows: 11 "<u>20-2-779.1.</u> 12 (a) Each public school in this state shall permit a student to exit a classroom for use of the 13 restroom upon request by such student. No student shall be subject to discipline pursuant 14 to Part 2 of this article or otherwise for exiting a classroom for use of the restroom, 15 provided that such student notifies his or her teacher of his or her need to exit the classroom for use of the restroom and there is no evidence that such student did not report to the 16 17 restroom, did not make an immediate return to the classroom, or spent an extended and unreasonable amount of time in the use of the restroom without justification. 18 19 (b) A teacher shall request that a school nurse, or principal or assistant principal if such 20 school nurse is not available, attend to any student who has exited the classroom for use 21 of the restroom and who remains within the restroom for an extended and unreasonable 22 amount of time. (c) Each local board of education shall establish criteria for determining excessive requests 23 for use of the restroom by a student. Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this Code section, 24

a student deemed to have made such excessive requests within a class for the school year

shall be permitted to exit a classroom for use of the restroom under such conditions as

determined by the local board of education; provided, however, that if such student has

- 28 provided sufficient medical documentation for such excessive requests, then the provisions
- of subsection (a) of this Code section shall be applicable to such student.
- 30 (d) Each local board of education shall adopt policies to carry out the purposes of this
- 31 <u>Code section.</u>"
- 32 **SECTION 2.**
- 33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
