To amend Code Section 17-8-54 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 1 2 persons allowed to be present in a courtroom when a person under the age of 16 testifies 3 concerning a sex offense, so as to add victim assistance personnel to the list of persons who may be present in a courtroom when a person under the age of 16 testifies concerning a sex 4 offense; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Code Section 17-8-54 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to persons allowed 9 to be present in a courtroom when a person under the age of 16 testifies concerning a sex 10 offense, is amended as follows: 11 "17-8-54. In the trial of any criminal case, when any person under the age of 16 is testifying 12 concerning any sex sexual offense, the court shall clear the courtroom of all persons except 13 14 parties to the cause and their immediate families or guardians, attorneys and their 15 secretaries, officers of the court, victim assistance coordinators, victims' advocates, and

- 16 <u>such other victim assistance personnel as provided for by Code Section 15-18-14.2, jurors,</u>
