A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 7 of Chapter 10 of Title 9 and Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 17 of the
- 2 Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to continuances, so as to revise continuances
- 3 for members of the Board of Regents and the Attorney General; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 7 of Chapter 10 of Title 9 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 continuances, is amended by revising Code Section 9-10-151, relating to grounds for
- 9 continuance of a member of the Board of Regents, as follows:

- Should any member of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia or any
- member of the State Board of Education be engaged otherwise occupied, at the time of any
- meeting of the board, as counsel or party in any case pending in the courts of this state and
- should the case be called for trial during the regular session of the board, the absence of the
- member to attend the session shall be good ground for a postponement or continuance of
- the case until the session of the board has come to an end."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 17 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 19 continuances, is amended by revising Code Section 17-8-27, relating to grounds for granting
- 20 of continuances to the Attorney General, as follows:
- 21 "17-8-27.
- When any case pending in the courts of this state in which the Attorney General is of
- counsel is scheduled to be called for any purpose reason during sessions of the General
- Assembly or during a period of 15 days preceding or following sessions of the General
- Assembly, on motion of the Attorney General or an assistant attorney general, it shall be

- a good ground for continuance that the Attorney General and his staff are occupied in aid
 of the business of the General Assembly."
- 28 SECTION 3.
- 29 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 30 without such approval.
- 31 SECTION 4.
- 32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
