## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the issuance, expiration, and renewal of drivers' licenses, so as to provide for an
- 3 exception to the renewal fee requirements for certain persons who are retired law
- 4 enforcement officers in the renewal of noncommercial drivers' licenses; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 9 issuance, expiration, and renewal of drivers' licenses, is amended by revising the introductory
- 10 language of subsection (a) of Code Section 40-5-25, relating to applications, fees, provisions
- 11 for voluntary participation in various programs, and education of young people, as follows:
- 12 "(a) Every application for an instruction permit or for a driver's license shall be made upon
- a form furnished by the department. Except where otherwise provided by law, every Every
- application shall be accompanied by the proper license fee. The fees shall be as established
- by the Board of Driver Services, not to exceed:"

SECTION 2.

- 17 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 18 "<u>40-5-40.</u>

- 19 The department shall not impose any charge or fee of any type whatsoever for the renewal
- 20 <u>of a noncommercial driver's license of any retired law enforcement officer who was</u>
- 21 registered or certified at the time of his or her retirement by the Georgia Peace Officer
- 22 <u>Standards and Training Council and who is receiving benefits under the Employees'</u>
- 23 Retirement System of Georgia, the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund provided
- 24 <u>under Chapter 17 of Title 47, the Sheriffs' Retirement Fund of Georgia provided under</u>
- 25 Chapter 16 of Title 47, or a county or municipal retirement system."
