A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 4 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
 Annotated, relating to the Realizing Educational Achievement Can Happen (REACH)
 Scholarship, so as to provide that victims of human trafficking are eligible for such
 scholarship; to provide for the selection of REACH scholars; to provide for related matters;
 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1. 8 Part 4 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 9 relating to the Realizing Educational Achievement Can Happen (REACH) Scholarship, is 10 amended by revising paragraph (3) of Code Section 20-3-497, relating to establishment of 11 REACH scholarship and student requirements, as follows: 12 "(3) Qualify for the federal free or reduced lunch program or be a victim of human 13 trafficking:"

15	Said part is further amended by revising paragraph (4) of subsection (a) of Code Section
16	20-3-499, relating to selection of REACH scholars, and adding a new paragraph to read as
17	follows:
18	"(1.1) Identifying eligible students who are victims of human trafficking;"
19	"(4) Reviewing student packets, including the nomination form, proof of eligibility for
20	federal free or reduced lunch or as a victim of human trafficking, citizenship and
21	residency requirements, and grade, attendance, and discipline reports; and"

23	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
