A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 11 of Article 17 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to complaints policy for teachers and other school personnel, so as to
- 3 provide that performance ratings contained in personnel evaluations are subject to complaint;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 11 of Article 17 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to complaints policy for teachers and other school personnel, is amended by revising
- 9 Code Section 20-2-989.7, relating to matters not subject to complaint, as follows:
- 10 "20-2-989.7.
- 11 (a) The performance ratings contained in personnel evaluations conducted pursuant to
- 12 Code Section 20-2-210, professional Professional development plans, and job performance
- shall not be subject to complaint under the provisions of this part; provided, however, this
- shall not apply to procedural deficiencies on the part of the local school system or charter
- school in conducting an evaluation pursuant to Code Section 20-2-210. The termination,
- nonrenewal, demotion, suspension, or reprimand of any employee, as set forth in Code
- 17 Section 20-2-940, and the revocation, suspension, or denial of certificates of any employee,
- as set forth in Code Section 20-2-984.5, shall not be subject to complaint under the
- 19 provisions of this part.
- 20 (b) A certified employee who chooses to appeal under Code Section 20-2-1160 shall be
- 21 barred from pursuing the same complaint under this part."

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
