A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elementary and secondary education, so as to require local boards of education and certain
- 3 charter schools to hold at least two public meetings on the proposed annual operating budget;
- 4 to require that a summary of the proposed and adopted annual operating budget be posted on
- 5 the Internet; to require that the detailed annual operating budget be made available upon
- 6 request; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elementary and
- 10 secondary education, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>20-2-167.1.</u>

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- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Governing body' means the local board of education, governing council, governing
- board, or other entity by whatever name responsible for creating and implementing the
- budget of a local education agency.
- 16 (2) 'Local education agency' means any local school system and any charter school
- subject to the provisions of Article 31 or 31A of this chapter, except this shall not include
- college and career academies that are charter schools; conversion charter schools, as
- defined in Code Section 20-2-2062, whose charter is not held by a nonprofit corporation;
- or system charter schools, as defined in Code Section 20-2-2062.
- 21 (b) Each governing body shall hold at least two public meetings, which shall not occur
- within the same week, for the purpose of providing an opportunity for public input on its
- 23 proposed annual operating budget before adopting any budget; provided, however, that any
- 24 <u>other public meeting or hearing held that is related to the budget as required by law shall</u>
- 25 <u>satisfy all or a portion of such requirement. The governing body of a charter school with</u>
- 26 <u>a state-wide attendance zone and students residing in 25 percent or more of Georgia's</u>

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27	counties or in three or more counties which are not geographically contiguous shall conduct
28	one such public meeting virtually and one such public meeting in the county in which its
29	primary business office is located. The public meetings shall be advertised in a local
30	newspaper of general circulation which shall be the same newspaper in which other legal
31	announcements of the board of education are advertised.
32	(c) A summary of the annual operating budget proposed by the governing board and the
33	annual operating budget adopted by the governing board shall be posted on a publicly
34	available area of such governing body's website. The summary of the annual operating
35	budget adopted by the governing body shall be maintained on such publicly available area
36	of the website until the annual operating budget for the next fiscal year is adopted by the
37	governing body. In the event a governing body elects to post the line item detailed
38	proposed and adopted annual operating budgets on a publicly available area of its website,
39	it shall be deemed in compliance with this subsection.
40	(d) Upon request, each governing body shall provide to any person an electronic copy of
41	the line item detailed adopted annual operating budget in a format suitable for analysis at
42	no cost within three business days of such request, and the summary of the budget required
43	by subsection (c) of this Code section shall give notice of such right.
44	(e) The provisions of this Code section shall not be construed to apply to the operating
45	budget or accounting records of a nonprofit corporation itself that operates a charter
46	school."

48 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
