

ADOPTED

Senators Watson of the 1st, Brass of the 28th, Miller of the 49th, Kirk of the 13th, Ligon, Jr. of the 3rd, Burke of the 11th, Hufstetler of the 52nd and Kirkpatrick of the 32nd offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Health and Human Services substitute to HB 65*
 2 *(LC 37 2680S) by striking "Committee" on line 3 and inserting in its place "Commission".*

3 *By striking "Committee" on line 11 and inserting in its place "Commission".*

4 *By striking "committee" on lines 12, 18, 23, 25, 29, 32, 36, 38, 42, 45, and 49 and inserting*
 5 *in its place "commission" everywhere such term appears.*

6 *By inserting after "repealer;" on line 4 the following:*

7 *to provide for recommendations by the Georgia Composite Medical Board on additional*
 8 *conditions that may be treated by low THC oil;*

9 *By inserting between lines 50 and 51 the following:*

SECTION 2.

11 Said article is further amended in Code Section 31-2A-18, relating to the establishment of
 12 the Low THC Oil Patient Registry, definitions, purpose, registration cards, semiannual
 13 reports, and waiver forms, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

14 "(h) The board shall annually review the conditions included in paragraph (3) of
 15 subsection (a) of this Code section and recommend additional conditions that have been
 16 shown through research to be effectively treated with low THC oil. Such recommendations
 17 shall include recommended dosages for a particular condition, patient responses to
 18 treatment with respect to the particular condition, and drug interactions with other drugs
 19 commonly taken by patients with the particular condition. Such recommendations shall
 20 be made to the General Assembly no later than December 1 of each year."

21 *By redesignating Section 2 as Section 3.*
