A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to courts, so as to create a new Judicial Qualifications
- 3 Commission; to provide for the powers, composition, and appointment of such commission;
- 4 to amend Code Section 50-14-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 5 certain proceedings exempted from open meetings requirements, so as to remove any
- 6 exemptions for meetings of the Judicial Qualifications Commission; to provide effective
- 7 dates; to provide for contingent automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 8 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 11 Chapter 1 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 12 provisions relative to courts, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 13 "<u>15-1-12.1.</u>
- 14 (a) Pursuant to Paragraph VI of Section VII of Article VI of the Constitution, there is
- hereby created the Judicial Qualifications Commission, which shall have the power to
- discipline, remove, and cause involuntary retirement of judges in accordance with said
- 17 Paragraph.
- 18 (b) The commission shall consist of seven members, as follows:
- 19 (1) Two judges of any court of record, selected by the Supreme Court;
- 20 (2) Three members of the State Bar of Georgia who shall have been active status
- 21 members of the state bar for at least ten years and who shall be appointed by the
- 22 <u>Governor</u>;
- 23 (3) One member of the State Bar of Georgia who shall have been an active status
- 24 member of the state bar for at least ten years and who shall be appointed by the Speaker
- of the House of Representatives; and

26 (4) One member of the State Bar of Georgia who shall have been an active status

- 27 member of the state bar for at least ten years and who shall be appointed by the President
- of the Senate.
- 29 (c) The commission may adopt procedures for its own governance which are not otherwise
- 30 provided by the Constitution."

31 SECTION 2.

- 32 Code Section 50-14-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to certain
- 33 proceedings exempted from open meetings requirements, is amended by adding a new
- 34 subsection to read as follows:
- 35 "(c) The exemptions provided by subsections (a) and (b) of this Code section shall not
- apply to meetings of the Judicial Qualifications Commission."
- 37 **SECTION 3.**
- 38 (a) Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2017, only if an amendment
- 39 to the Constitution abolishing the existing Judicial Qualifications Commission and
- 40 requiring the General Assembly to create and provide by general law for the composition
- and manner of appointment of a new Judicial Qualifications Commission, with such
- 42 commission having the power to discipline, remove, and cause involuntary retirement of
- judges, is ratified by the voters at the November, 2016, state-wide general election. If such
- an amendment is not so ratified, then Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective and
- shall stand repealed on January 1, 2017.
- 46 (b) All other provisions of this Act shall become effective upon approval of this Act by the
- 47 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
- 48 SECTION 4.
- 49 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
