## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to courts, so as to create a new Judicial Qualifications
- 3 Commission; to provide for the powers, composition, and appointment of such commission;
- 4 to provide for a commission member's term; to amend Code Section 50-14-3 of the Official
- 5 Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to certain proceedings exempted from open meetings
- 6 requirements, so as to remove any exemptions for meetings of the Judicial Qualifications
- 7 Commission; to provide effective dates; to provide for contingent automatic repeal; to repeal
- 8 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

10 SECTION 1.

- 11 Chapter 1 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 12 provisions relative to courts, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 13 "<u>15-1-12.1.</u>
- 14 (a) Pursuant to Paragraph VI of Section VII of Article VI of the Constitution, there is
- hereby created the Judicial Qualifications Commission, which shall have the power to
- discipline, remove, and cause involuntary retirement of judges in accordance with said
- 17 <u>Paragraph.</u>
- 18 (b) The commission shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall serve for a term
- of four years, as follows:
- 20 (1) Two judges of any court of record, selected by the Supreme Court;
- 21 (2) One member of the State Bar of Georgia who shall have been an active status
- 22 member of the state bar for at least ten years and who shall be appointed by the Governor;
- 23 (3) One member of the State Bar of Georgia who shall have been an active status
- 24 <u>member of the state bar for at least ten years and who shall be appointed by the Speaker</u>
- of the House of Representatives;

26 (4) One member of the State Bar of Georgia who shall have been an active status

- 27 member of the state bar for at least ten years and who shall be appointed by the President
- of the Senate; and
- 29 (5) Two citizens, neither of whom shall be a member of the State Bar of Georgia, who
- 30 <u>shall be appointed by the Governor.</u>
- 31 (c) The commission may adopt procedures for its own governance which are not otherwise
- 32 provided by the Constitution."

33 SECTION 2.

- 34 Code Section 50-14-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to certain
- 35 proceedings exempted from open meetings requirements, is amended by adding a new
- 36 subsection to read as follows:
- 37 "(c) The exemptions provided by subsections (a) and (b) of this Code section shall not
- 38 apply to meetings of the Judicial Qualifications Commission."

SECTION 3.

- 40 (a) Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2017, only if an amendment
- 41 to the Constitution abolishing the existing Judicial Qualifications Commission and
- requiring the General Assembly to create and provide by general law for the composition
- and manner of appointment of a new Judicial Qualifications Commission, with such
- commission having the power to discipline, remove, and cause involuntary retirement of
- judges, is ratified by the voters at the November, 2016, state-wide general election. If such
- an amendment is not so ratified, then Section 1 of this Act shall not become effective and
- shall stand repealed on January 1, 2017.
- 48 (b) All other provisions of this Act shall become effective upon approval of this Act by the
- 49 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

SECTION 4.

51 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
