A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 24-4-417 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to evidence of similar acts in prosecutions for violations of Code Section 40-6-391, so as to require similar acts of such violations be after a conviction thereof; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 24-4-417 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to evidence of
8	similar acts in prosecutions for violations of Code Section 40-6-391, is amended by revising
9	subsection (a) as follows:
10	"(a) In a criminal proceeding involving a prosecution for a violation of Code Section
11	40-6-391, evidence of the commission of a conviction for another violation of Code
12	Section 40-6-391 on a different occasion by the same accused shall be admissible when:
13	(1) The accused refused in the current case to take the state administered test required
14	by Code Section 40-5-55 and such evidence is relevant to prove knowledge, plan, or
15	absence of mistake or accident;
16	(2) The accused refused in the current case to provide an adequate breath sample for the
17	state administered test required by Code Section 40-5-55 and such evidence is relevant
18	to prove knowledge, plan, or absence of mistake or accident; or
19	(3) The identity of the driver is in dispute in the current case and such evidence is
20	relevant to prove identity."
