A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to invasions of privacy, so as to prohibit the transmission of photography or video
- 3 depicting nudity or sexually explicit conduct of an adult under certain circumstances; to
- 4 provide for definitions; to provide for penalties; to provide for venue; to provide for
- 5 exceptions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 3 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 invasions of privacy, is amended by adding a new part to read as follows:

10 "<u>Part 3</u>

- 11 <u>16-11-90.</u>
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 13 (1) 'Harassment' means engaging in conduct directed at a depicted person that is intended
- 14 <u>to cause substantial emotional harm to the depicted person.</u>
- 15 (2) 'Nudity' means:
- 16 (A) The showing of the human male or female genitals, pubic area, or buttocks without
- any covering or with less than a full opaque covering;
- 18 (B) The showing of the female breasts without any covering or with less than a full
- 19 <u>opaque covering; or</u>
- 20 (C) The depiction of covered male genitals in a discernibly turgid state.
- 21 (3) 'Sexually explicit conduct' shall have the same meaning as set forth in Code Section
- 22 16-12-100.
- 23 (b) A person violates this Code section if he or she knowingly and without the consent of

25 (1) Electronically transmits or posts, in one or more transmissions or posts, a photograph

- or video which depicts nudity or sexually explicit conduct of an adult when the
- 27 <u>transmission or post is harassment or causes financial loss to the depicted person and</u>
- 28 <u>serves no legitimate purpose to the depicted person; or</u>
- 29 (2) Causes the electronic transmission or posting, in one or more transmissions or posts,
- 30 of a photograph or video which depicts nudity or sexually explicit conduct of an adult
- 31 when the transmission or post is harassment or causes financial loss to the depicted
- 32 person and serves no legitimate purpose to the depicted person.
- 33 (c) Any person who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high
- 34 and aggravated nature; provided, however, that upon a second or subsequent violation of
- 35 <u>this Code section, he or she shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall</u>
- 36 <u>be punished by imprisonment of not less than one nor more than five years, a fine of not</u>
- 37 more than \$100,000.00, or both.
- 38 (d) A person shall be subject to prosecution in this state pursuant to Code Section 17-2-1
- 39 <u>for any conduct made unlawful by this Code section which the person engages in while:</u>
- 40 (1) Either within or outside of this state if, by such conduct, the person commits a
- 41 <u>violation of this Code section which involves an individual who resides in this state; or</u>
- 42 (2) Within this state if, by such conduct, the person commits a violation of this Code

- 44 (e) The provisions of subsection (b) of this Code section shall not apply to:

57 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
