A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 regulation of alcoholic beverages generally, so as to provide for Sunday sales of alcoholic 3 beverages for consumption on the premises in locally designated special entertainment 4 districts; to provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective 5 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Chapter 3 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to regulation of 9 alcoholic beverages generally, is amended in Code Section 3-3-7, relating to local 10 authorization and regulation of sales of alcoholic beverages on Sunday, by adding a new 11 subsection to read as follows: 12 ''(s)(1) As used in this subsection, the term 'special entertainment district' means 13 contiguous properties upon which is located a festival marketplace and entertainment 14 project which receives or has received financing in whole or in part by public funds and 15 which contains a minimum of 200,000 square feet of gross leasable space for retail sales 16 and entertainment purposes and which is located in the central business district of a

17	municipality if more than 50 percent of such contiguous properties are owned or
18	controlled by a governmental entity.

- 19 (2) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a municipality may, by resolution or
- 20 <u>ordinance, authorize in any locally designated special entertainment district the sale of</u>
- 21 <u>alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises:</u>
- (A) On Saturdays from 11:55 P.M. and the three hours immediately following such
 time; and
- 24 (B) On Sundays from 11:00 A.M. until 12:00 Midnight."

25 SECTION 2.
26 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
27 without such approval.
28 SECTION 3.

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
