A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 31-7-12.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 unlicensed personal care homes, so as to revise provisions relating to penalties for owning
- 3 or operating an unlicensed personal care home; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 31-7-12.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to unlicensed
- 8 personal care homes, is amended by revising subsection (f) and adding a new subsection to
- 9 read as follows:

- 10 "(f) It is declared that the owning or operating of an unlicensed personal care home in this
- state constitutes a nuisance dangerous to the public health, safety, and welfare. The
- 12 <u>commissioner or the district attorney of the judicial circuit in which such unlicensed</u>
- personal care home is located may file a petition to abate such nuisance as provided in
- Chapter 2 of Title 41.
- 15 (g) Any person who owns or operates a personal care home in violation of subsection (b)
- of Code Section 31-7-12 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor <u>for a first violation</u>, <u>unless such</u>
- 17 <u>violation is in conjunction with abuse, neglect, or exploitation as defined in Code Section</u>
- 18 <u>30-5-3, in which case such person shall be guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, shall</u>
- be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years. Upon
- 20 <u>conviction for</u> a second <u>or subsequent</u> such violation, such person shall be guilty of a
- felony and, upon conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor
- 22 more than ten years."

SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
