A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act creating a board of commissioners for the County of Grady, approved
- 2 December 22, 1937 (Ga. L. 1937-38, Ex. Sess. p. 837), as amended, so as to change the
- 3 compensation of the board; to remove the board's authority to fix the salary of the
- 4 chairperson; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act creating a board of commissioners for the County of Grady, approved
- 9 December 22, 1937 (Ga. L. 1937-38, Ex. Sess. p. 837), as amended, is amended by striking
- subsection (f) of Section 5 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 11 "(f) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this Section to the contrary, the board of
- commissioners as a whole shall have the authority to define and limit the duties to be
- performed by the chairperson of the board."

14 SECTION 2.

15 Said Act is further amended by striking Section 8 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16 "SECTION 8.

- 17 (a) The chairperson of the board of commissioners shall receive 17 percent of the base
- salary of the Clerk of Superior Court of Grady County as compensation to be paid from
- 19 county funds.
- 20 (b) All other members of the board of commissioners shall receive 12 percent of the base
- salary of the Clerk of Superior Court of Grady County as compensation to be paid from
- county funds; provided, however, that any such member who has been designated as a
- certified county commissioner pursuant to Code Section 36-5-27 of the Official Code of

- Georgia Annotated shall receive 14 percent of the base salary of the Clerk of Superior
- 25 Court of Grady County as compensation to be paid from county funds."

SECTION 3.

- 27 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
- 28 it is approved by the Governor or becomes law without such approval.

29 SECTION 4.

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
