A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 veterans' licenses, honorary licenses, and other distinctive licenses, so as to provide for
3 qualifications for the issuance of veterans' driver's licenses; to provide for related matters;
4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 Code Section 40-5-36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to veterans'
8 licenses, honorary licenses, and other distinctive licenses, is amended by revising
9 subsection (c) as follows:

10 "(c) Veterans' licenses may be issued to:

11 (1) Veterans who ~~were residents of Georgia at the time of enlistment or commissioning~~
12 ~~and are:~~

13 ~~(A) Are residents at the time of application for the license, or who have been residents~~
14 ~~of Georgia for at least two years immediately preceding the date of application for the~~
15 ~~license, who served;~~

16 ~~(B) Served~~ on active duty in the armed forces of the United States or on active duty in
17 a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States, including the National
18 Guard, during wartime or any conflict when personnel were committed by the President
19 of the United States, whether or not such veteran was assigned to a unit or division
20 which directly participated in such war or conflict, except for periodic transfer from
21 reserve status to active duty status for training purposes, ~~and who were;~~ and

22 ~~(C) Were discharged or separated under honorable conditions; and~~

23 (2) All members or former members of the National Guard or reserve forces who
24 have 20 or more years' creditable service therein."

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
