A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 80 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 provisions applicable to counties, municipal corporations, and other governmental entities,
- 3 so as to provide that any service contract such entities enter into shall contain a termination
- 4 clause; to provide that poor performance or cost overrun shall constitute cause for
- 5 termination of the contract; to provide for applicability; to provide for related matters; to
- 6 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 80 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to provisions
- 10 applicable to counties, municipal corporations, and other governmental entities, is amended
- 11 by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 12 "<u>36-80-24.</u>

- Any service contract with a political subdivision entered into or renewed on or after July
- 14 1, 2014, shall contain specific performance and cost parameters, and the contractor shall
- 15 <u>submit quarterly reports to the governing authority or other contracting authority showing</u>
- the contractor's compliance with such performance criteria and the actual costs for which
- the political subdivision is obligated. Each such contract shall contain a provision
- authorizing, but not requiring, the political subdivision to terminate the contract if the
- 19 contractor fails to comply with the performance criteria or if projected annual costs exceed
- 21 political subdivision may cancel the contract at any time if the contractor fails to comply

the cost established by the contract. The contract shall also contain a provision that the

- with all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations; provided, however, that
- 23 any such contract shall be subject to termination on those grounds whether or not the
- 24 <u>contract so specifies."</u>
