

House Bill 986 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing that the governing authority of each county comprising the
2 Waycross Judicial Circuit may supplement the compensation, salary, expenses, and
3 allowances of each of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit,
4 approved March 20, 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 3879), so as to increase the amounts of such
5 supplements; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
6 laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 An Act providing that the governing authority of each county comprising the Waycross
10 Judicial Circuit may supplement the compensation, salary, expenses, and allowances of each
11 of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit, approved March 20,
12 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 3879), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:

13 "Section 1. In addition to the compensation, salary, expenses, and allowances presently
14 being received by the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross Judicial Circuit from
15 the State of Georgia or from any other source, the governing authority of each county
16 comprising the Waycross Judicial Circuit shall supplement the compensation, salary,
17 expenses, and allowances of each of the judges of the superior courts of the Waycross
18 Judicial Circuit. The division of payment among the six counties shall not be less than the
19 following amounts for each judge:

26 **SECTION 2.**

27 This Act shall become effective upon approval by the Governor or upon becoming law
28 without such approval.

29 **SECTION 3.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
