A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to offenses related to minors generally, so as to provide for the offense
- 3 of grooming a minor for indecent purposes; to provide for a definition; to provide for a
- 4 penalty; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to offenses related to minors generally, is amended by adding a new Code section
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 "16-12-100.5.
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'grooming' means actions or behaviors used by
- an adult to establish an emotional connection with a minor to gain such minor's trust, for
- the eventual objective of sexual abuse, manipulation, or exploitation. Such actions and
- behaviors may include, but are not limited to, contact made online, in person, or by other
- means of communication.

16 (b) A person commits the crime of grooming a minor when such person makes contact

- with a minor to establish trust with the eventual objective of arousing the sexual desire of
- 18 <u>either the minor or such person.</u>
- (c) Any person who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a felony and punished by
- imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years."

- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
