## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 11-17, 2024, as Future Business Leaders of America Week in the  
2 State of Georgia; and for other purposes.

4 organization whose first chapter was established in Johnson City, Tennessee, in 1942; and

5 WHEREAS, Iowa became FBLA's first state chapter in 1947; and

7 November 20, 1967; and

8 WHEREAS, FBLA includes more than 250,000 members and advisers in 4,600 chapters  
9 nationwide in middle schools, high schools, colleges, universities, career and technical  
10 schools, and private business schools; and

12 and education together in a positive working relationship through innovative leadership and  
13 career development programs; and

14 WHEREAS, FBLA members perform community service activities and strive to build a
