## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Jerry "Pops" Barnes as the Distinguished Older Georgian
- 2 for 2020; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Jerry "Pops" Barnes retired from the United States Army after serving for
- 4 20 years as a master sergeant E-8; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes, a registered nurse, was one of the first nurses assigned to the
- 6 Columbus Red Cross shelter relief operations and has operated shelters during the flooding
- 7 in Harris County in 2003 and during Hurricane Ivan in 2004; he was also one of the first
- 8 nurses to operate a shelter during Hurricane Katrina; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in 2002, Mr. Barnes dedicated himself to aiding the community by providing
- 10 free health education, screening, and case management through his organization, "The Pan
- 11 Columbus Wellness Project"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes does free community health nursing on a regular basis in homes,
- 13 recreation centers, and churches; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes assists in organizing numerous health fairs in the community, writes
- 15 a weekly health column in the *Columbus Times*, and produces a daily television show called
- 16 "Focus on Health" to help people make healthy lifestyle choices and informed health care
- 17 decisions; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes has been an active member of the Coalition of Advocates for
- 19 Georgia's Elderly and has been an active Meals on Wheels volunteer for over three years; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes was invited by the National Minority Quality Forum, the
- 21 Congressional Black Caucus Foundation Inc., and the American Medical Association in
- 22 cooperation with the Congressional Black Caucus of the Congress of the United States to

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23 speak in Washington D.C. at the Spring Health Brain Trust and Fifth Annual Health

- 24 Disparities Leadership Summit; and
- 25 WHEREAS, in December 2017, Mr. Barnes started the Aging Advocacy Coalition in
- 26 partnership with the River Valley Area Agency on Aging as a result of his determination to
- 27 prevent the cutting of the SHIP program at the federal level; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes is an advocate for the disabled military; and
- 29 WHEREAS, in September 2019, Mr. Barnes was recognized by the Southeastern Association
- 30 of Area Agencies on Aging as the Outstanding Volunteer of the Year; and
- 31 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes has fulfilled his campaign promises of opening recreation centers
- 32 that had been closed since 1997 while providing social services and health care to the
- 33 community; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Mr. Barnes successfully passed a local option sales tax to hire an additional 100
- 35 law enforcement officers and opened a new precinct in the heart of District 1 in Columbus,
- 36 Georgia; and
- 37 WHEREAS, Mr. Jerry "Pop" Barnes has advocated for the allocation of \$38.1 million dollars
- 38 to District 1 to maintain the local infrastructure.
- 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 40 the members of this body recognize and commend Mr. Jerry "Pop" Barnes as the
- 41 Distinguished Older Georgian for 2020 and as an exemplary councilmember of District 1.
- 42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Mr.
