A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Stephen Day and dedicating an interchange in his memory; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Stephen Day was born on was born in Decatur, Georgia, in 1952, and
4 graduated from Georgia Tech's School of Industrial and Systems Engineering; and

5 WHEREAS, through his company, Day Energy LLC, Mr. Day consulted on biomass energy
6 projects and bought and sold hundreds of thousands of tons of wood waste that was
7 indigenous to Georgia, which provided sustainable carbon neutral fuel for the state; and

8 WHEREAS, a dedicated member of his community, Mr. Day served on several Gwinnett
9 County school councils, multiple Gwinnett County waste water planning committees, and
10 on the Gwinnett Board of Registration and Elections; and

11 WHEREAS, his leadership and guidance were instrumental to the DeKalb, Gwinnett, and
12 Georgia democratic parties; and

13 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Day was an active member and deacon at
14 First Baptist Church of Decatur; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
16 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an interchange in his memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the interchange of State Route 316 and State Route 120 in
19 Gwinnett County is dedicated as the Stephen Day Memorial Interchange.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Stephen Day Memorial
22 Interchange.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
25 family of Mr. Stephen Day and to the Department of Transportation.
