A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Charlotte Nash on her decades of outstanding public service
2 and leadership; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the honorable Charlotte Nash has long been recognized by the citizens of this
4 state for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment
5 to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by her decades of public service; and

9 WHEREAS, a graduate of Dacula High School in Gwinnett County, Mrs. Nash dedicated
10 27 years to Gwinnett County government prior to her retirement in 2004, serving in roles as
11 grants manager, budget director, director of financial services, and county administrator; and

12 WHEREAS, upon her retirement, Mrs. Nash went to work for a consulting firm specializing
13 in management and governmental and public strategy; and

14 WHEREAS, she was elected a chair of the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners in

15 2011 where her significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience and
16 diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of
17 Gwinnett County earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Nash's leadership and guidance have been instrumental to numerous
19 organizations, including the Gwinnett Recreation Authority, Atlanta Regional Commission,
20 Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District, Association County Commissioners
21 of Georgia, and the ATL (Atlanta-Region Transit Link); and

22 WHEREAS, she has been recognized with numerous honors and accolades, including being
23 named to the 100 Most Influential Atlantans list by *The Atlanta Business Chronicle* every
24 year since 2011 and being included among the 100 Most Influential Georgians by *Georgia*
25 *Trend* since 2013; and

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
27 Georgian be recognized appropriately.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
29 the members of this body recognize and commend Charlotte Nash for her decades of
30 outstanding public service and leadership and extend the most sincere best wishes for
31 continued health and happiness.
