A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Johns Creek on being named number one on the Federal Bureau of
- 2 Investigation's 40 safest cities in Georgia list for 2015; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the most recent Federal Bureau of Investigation crime report revealed that
- 4 Georgia reported 3.59 incidents of violent crime and 33.46 incidents of property crime per
- 5 1,000 residents, which is an impressive 7 percent overall decrease in crime since the Federal
- 6 Bureau of Investigation's last statistics were released; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the safest cities in Georgia boast an average violent crime rate of 1.86 per 1,000
- 8 residents, which is roughly half of the national average, and a property crime rate that is
- 9 nearly 30 percent less than most United States cities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Safe Wise Report created the 40 safest cities in Georgia list by analyzing
- the most recent Federal Bureau of Investigation crime report data of cities with at least 4,000
- 12 residents as of 2013, examining the number of violent crimes, such as murder, robbery,
- 13 forcible rape, and aggravated assault, and property crimes, such as burglary, arson, motor
- vehicle theft, and larceny theft, that occurred in each city, and then calculating how often
- 15 these crimes were reported per 1,000 people; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Johns Creek police department is a professional law enforcement
- 17 organization that prides itself on delivering the highest level of service to the 76,728
- 18 residents and nearly 2,000 businesses in Georgia's 10th largest city; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the Johns Creek police department offers innovative programs, such as PACT
- 20 (Police and Community Together) and the SHIELD business watch program, that play an
- 21 integral role in the safety of the citizens of Johns Creek; and

WHEREAS, Johns Creek's crime rate is 75 percent less than the national average, including

- 23 a violent crime occurrence of .43 per 1,000 citizens and a property crime rate of 7.36 per
- 24 1,000 citizens.
- 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 26 the members of this body commend Johns Creek on being named the safest city in Georgia
- 27 by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 30 police department of Johns Creek.
