A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on the Exchange, Storage, and Bond Coverage of
- 2 Agricultural Products, Grain, and Livestock; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, agriculture has been, and remains, Georgia's top industry; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Georgia's farmers and producers face numerous economic pressures, including
- 5 the threat of litigation, cost inflation with respect to supplies and equipment, and volatile
- 6 prices for their crops; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the number of surety bond claims made to the Georgia Department of
- 8 Agriculture is steadily increasing and a significant number bond filings have been avoided
- 9 through amicable resolutions; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the department's Warehouse and Bonding Division is focused on protecting
- 11 Georgia's various agricultural commodity producers from fraudulent actions by ensuring that
- 12 warehouses are licensed and maintain adequate surety bond coverage; and

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WHEREAS, the mission of the Warehouse and Bonding Division is to help protect Georgia's

- 14 producers by providing limited financial protection through the maintenance of adequate
- 15 surety bond coverage; and
- WHEREAS, the House of Representatives should evaluate warehouse and bonding policies
- 17 and best practices implemented in other states and seek the advice of experts in the various
- 18 fields associated with the topic, including, but not limited to, Georgia's agricultural
- 19 producers, lawyers, and financial institutions, in considering additional measures that may
- 20 be necessary and appropriate for Georgia.
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 22 (1) Creation of House study committee. There is created the House Study Committee
- on the Exchange, Storage, and Bond Coverage of Agricultural Products, Grain, and
- 24 Livestock.
- 25 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of seven members of the
- House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 27 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.
- 29 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- 30 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- 31 legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 32 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 36 (5) Allowances and funding. The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia

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Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any

- member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.

42 (6) **Report.**

- 43 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that 44 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 47 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- 49 of this paragraph.
- 50 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- 53 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 56 thereof.
- 57 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2024.
