- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. J. David Williams was born in, and is a lifelong resident of, Oconee
3 County; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he is considered a "Double Dawg," having obtained both his Bachelor and
5 Masters degrees in agriculture from the University of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
7 States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during the Vietnam
8 War; and
- 9 WHEREAS, engaged in his community, Mr. Williams served as a board member of VFW
10 Post 9147 and Oconee Veteran's Memorial Foundation, chairman of the Oconee County
11 Chamber of Commerce, member of the Oconee County Board of Education, logistics
12 coordinator for the Oconee Chamber Fall Festival, and building renovator coordinator for the
13 Oconee Chamber; and
