## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Sharon Seay and recognizing March 7, 2024, as Women in  
2 Radio Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Sharon Seay has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital  
4 role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of  
5 the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she is a former radio personality in news and public affairs; and

7 WHEREAS, her career spans over two decades as a radio and television news reporter and  
8 talk show host at WAOK and WSB radio and television stations in Atlanta, Georgia, and she  
9 was also an on-air traffic reporter for Metro Traffic Control; and

10 WHEREAS, before moving to Atlanta, she was a news reporter at WDOD Radio in  
11 Chattanooga, Tennessee, as one of the second black reporters in the city; and

12 WHEREAS, while in Chattanooga, she and a group of radio personalities hosted Black  
13 history programs for the public broadcast television station; and

14 WHEREAS, in 1993, she combined her background in journalism and hospitality and  
15 spawned a career in private consulting; and

16 WHEREAS, she is a certified event and meeting professional, where she assists companies  
17 with planning extraordinary events, does voice-over work, and serves as an emcee for special  
18 events and nonprofit organizations; and

19 WHEREAS, she is a member of numerous boards and professional organizations; and

20 WHEREAS, her significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable patience and  
21 diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this state have  
22 earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
24 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
26 the members of this body recognize and commend Sharon Seay, recognize March 7, 2024,  
27 as Women in Radio Day at the state capitol, and thank her for her efforts of behalf of her  
28 community and state.
