## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Georgia Southern University and inviting Dr. Brooks A. Keel to be recognized
- 2 by the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, when First District Agricultural & Mechanical School's inaugural academic
- 4 year began in 1908, few could have foreseen a major American university growing out of
- 5 four faculty members and 15 students; and
- 6 WHEREAS, over 100 years later, Georgia Southern University boasts more than 20,000
- 7 students, 2,000 faculty and staff, and more than 100 programs of study at the bachelor's,
- 8 master's, and doctoral levels; and
- 9 WHEREAS, located an hour outside of historical Savannah, Hilton Head Island, and the
- 10 Atlantic coast, Georgia Southern's 900-plus acre campus is nestled in the classic Main Street
- 11 community of Statesboro, Georgia, which is home to more than 70,000 residents; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern's current enrollment stands at 20,517 students, and for the
- 13 third consecutive year has been recognized by U.S. News and World Report on its annual list
- 14 of best online education programs, which included the graduate computer information
- 15 technology, graduate education, graduate business, and online bachelor's programs; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern has been named a military-friendly school for the third year
- in a row by *Military Advanced Education* in its 2014 Guide to Military-Friendly Colleges and
- 18 Universities; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the university's Fashion and Merchandising and Apparel Design program was
- 20 named one of the top fashion merchandising schools in the United States by
- 21 fashion-schools.org and was also ranked ninth on the list of Top 15 Fashion Schools in the
- 22 South; and

23 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern's Master of Business Administration (MBA) program was

- ranked in the top ten as one of the nation's Top Online MBA programs by M magazine, the
- 25 number one online MBA magazine for students;
- 26 WHEREAS, the university's College of Business Administration (COBA) was recognized
- as one of the best business schools for United States veterans by *Military Times*; and
- 28 WHEREAS, student-athletes earned top honors in the classroom this year, with a total of 175
- 29 Georgia Southern University Eagles named to the Southern Conference's academic honor
- 30 roll; a record high of 18 Eagles posted a 4.0 grade point average and 89 student-athletes
- 31 earned the Commissioner's Medal for attaining a GPA of 3.5 or higher throughout the
- 32 2012-2013 academic year; and
- 33 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern University's online Bachelor of Information Technology has
- 34 been ranked as one of the top 20 "best buys" in the country by the education website,
- 35 geteducated.com; and
- 36 WHEREAS, for the second year in a row, the university has been ranked one of the top ten
- 37 most popular universities in the nation by *U.S. News and World Report*; Georgia Southern
- 38 tied with Yale University for the number seven spot on the 2012 list; and
- 39 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern University has been named one of America's Best Colleges
- 40 by Forbes magazine, whose rankings include the top 20 percent of colleges and universities
- 41 based on the students' point of view; and
- 42 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern's College of Business Administration has been named one
- 43 of the best business schools in the country by *The Princeton Review*; the publication
- 44 recognized Georgia Southern in *The Best 294 Business Schools*; and
- WHEREAS, the university's online Master of Science in computer science has been ranked
- as one of the top ten "best buys" in the country by the education website, *geteducated.com*,
- 47 a consumer group that rates, ranks, and verifies the cost and credibility of online colleges and
- 48 universities; and
- 49 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern's Master of Science in Nursing-Family Nurse Practitioner
- 50 program has been ranked in the top 20 nationally by U.S. News and World Report; the

51 program has also secured top honors among all colleges and universities in Georgia, both

- 52 public and private; and
- 53 WHEREAS, the School of Nursing itself is ranked in the top 80 nationally by *U.S. News and*
- 54 World Report's Best Graduate Schools; and
- 55 WHEREAS, the Construction Management program at Georgia Southern is the largest of its
- 56 kind in the state; and
- 57 WHEREAS, the ROTC Eagle Battalion (Military Science) at Georgia Southern is now the
- 58 largest in the Southeastern United States at a nonmilitary university campus; and
- 59 WHEREAS, Georgia Southern University's ROTC program is a consecutive winner of the
- 60 prestigious MacArthur Award, which is presented to the top eight ROTC programs in the
- 61 country; and
- 62 WHEREAS, Dr. Brooks A. Keel became the 12th president of Georgia Southern University
- 63 on January 1, 2010; and
- 64 WHEREAS, prior to joining Georgia Southern, Dr. Keel was the Vice Chancellor for
- 65 Research and Economic Development and Professor of Biological Sciences at Louisiana
- 66 State University; and
- 67 WHEREAS, Dr. Keel is a native of Georgia and received his Ph.D. in reproductive
- 68 endocrinology from the Medical College of Georgia in 1982, and also served as the
- 69 Associate Vice President for Research, Vice President of the Research Foundation, and
- 70 Professor of Biological Sciences at Florida State University; and
- 71 WHEREAS, he was the first recipient of the Daniel K. Roberts Distinguished Professorship,
- an endowed chair in Obstetrics and Gynecology, in 1995; and
- 73 WHEREAS, Dr. Keel is a member of numerous professional organizations and societies,
- 74 including the Society for Gynecologic Investigation, American Society for Reproductive
- 75 Medicine, Society for the Study of Reproduction, and the Endocrine Society, and has
- authored 65 peer-reviewed scientific publications.

77 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that

- 78 the members of this body commend Georgia Southern University on its many
- 79 accomplishments and invite Dr. Brooks A. Keel to be recognized by the House of
- 80 Representatives at a date and time to be determined by the Speaker of the House.

- 82 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Georgia Southern University
