- 19 Honor Society member, and serves as a dance captain and co-chair of the Thespian Society;
- 20 she has received many accolades, including the Outstanding Georgia Citizenship Award and
- 21 Accelerated Math Department Student of the Year, and was a featured dancer at the Shuler
