## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February as American Heart Month; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia celebrates the extraordinary progress in heart health and
- 3 recognizes that more needs to be done in Georgia to safeguard heart health for generations
- 4 to come; and
- 5 WHEREAS, heart disease is the number one killer of Americans and Georgians; and
- 6 WHEREAS, there are over 350,000 out-of-hospital cardiac arrests in the United States and
- 7 over 10,000 in Georgia annually; and
- 8 WHEREAS, of all sudden death victims, 80 percent are shown to have underlying heart
- 9 disease; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the survival rate for out-of-hospital cardiac arrest averages under 11 percent
- 11 annually; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the best outcomes from cardiac arrest depends upon immediate
- 13 bystander-initiated CPR and an early shock from an automated external defibrillator (AED);
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, less than 50 percent of cardiac arrest victims outside of a hospital receive
- 16 bystander-initiated CPR and less than 2 percent of victims receive a shock from a
- 17 bystander-initiated onsite AED; and
- 18 WHEREAS, keeping Georgians healthy and promoting awareness of health issues, including
- 19 heart disease, are important responsibilities and depend on the actions of many organizations
- and groups in our community; and

21 WHEREAS, Georgians are encouraged to take action to make heart health a priority for their

- 22 communities, their families, and themselves; to become aware of their risk of heart disease
- and cardiac arrest; and to work together to promote better outcomes in heart health of all
- 24 Georgians.
- 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 26 the members of this body recognize February as American Heart Month and urge the people
- 27 of the United States to give heed to the nationwide and statewide problem of heart and blood
- vessel diseases and to support all essential programs required to bring about a solution.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 30 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 31 public and the press.
