## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Jack M. “Bob” Plemons; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Jack M. “Bob” Plemons April 22, 2023; and
- 4 WHEREAS, his whole life was dedicated to serving others and making a difference; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty first with the United  
6 States Army and then with the United States Army Reserves, valiantly and courageously  
7 protecting his fellow Americans; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he served as a purchasing agent with Catoosa County, county manager with  
9 Gilmer County, and member of the State Soil and Water Conservation Commission under  
10 four governors for more than 20 years; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he served as a board member for the Department of Corrections, special  
12 projects manager with Chattooga County, assistant to the director of Engineering and  
13 Construction Services of the Department of Corrections, and the Engineering and

14 Construction Services assistant director, and retired as legislative liaison for the Department  
15 of Corrections, known by many as the "ambassador for the Department of Corrections"; and

16 WHEREAS, he was an inductee of the Georgia Association of Conservation District  
17 Supervisors Hall of Fame and the National Association of Conservation Districts Hall of  
18 Fame; and

19 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, he was an active member of the Burning Bush  
20 Baptist Church; and

21 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Glenda Johnson Plemons, and  
22 was blessed with two loving daughters, Christa and Joy; and

23 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
24 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
25 family and friends were admired by others; and

26 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
27 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
28 made this world a better place in which to live; and

29 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, he will long be remembered for his love  
30 of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great fortune of  
31 knowing him.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
33 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Jack M. “Bob” Plemons  
34 and express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
